



# Student Non-Uniform Policy

## PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to address the appropriate standard of dress for non-uniform days at Chinchilla Christian College and to give guidance to teachers, parents, students and administrators on how to follow up when a student is in breach of this policy.

## SCOPE

This policy applies to students for non-uniform days at school and to other school activities, including school social events and camps, in which they participate.

## POLICY AND PROCEDURE DETAILS

Clothing worn by students when in non-uniform needs to be consistent with the Christian ethos of the College (e.g. clothes cannot promote (by words, images or logos) drugs, evil, violence or unacceptable values). Clothing also needs to be modest. It is important that clothing is sun safe, including having a hat. No uniform items are to be included in the mix when students are in non-uniform dress (except for College hat that is permitted to be worn if necessary).

Closed in footwear is required (must be leather uppers for practical subjects e.g. Industrial Design and Technologies, Food Technologies, etc). Normal requirements for jewellery apply. Girls' hair may be out for the day. (Please note: if having a practical lesson, girls' hair will need to be tied back or kept off the face as per usual).

Students who arrive at school dressed inappropriately will need to correct their clothing otherwise a temporary school uniform will be provided for them for the day. The appropriateness of a student's non-uniform is determined by the Principal.
