Boys Formal Uniform

Primary Boys Prep to Year 6

- College navy bucket hat
- Sky blue buttoned shirt with CCC Logo (worn untucked)
- Navy gabardine short and/or navy gabardine pants Secondary navy dress trousers can be worn from Year 5 onward
- Plain navy crew socks



Secondary Boys

Year 7 to Year 12

- College navy bucket hat
- Sky blue buttoned shirt with CCC Logo (worn tucked in)
- Navy tie with red diagonal stripes To be worn on formal days Terms 2 and 3 only, and for special events held in Terms 1 and 4.
- Navy dress shorts and/or navy dress trousers
- Navy knee high socks with two thin red horizontal stripes around the turn-over top

Years 11 & 12 only

Navy blazer with red piping*

Note: Navy dress trousers are to be worn with the blazer (no dress shorts)

*Blazers are loaned out via an agreement with the College. There is no additional cost.



Boys Formal Uniform Winter

Primary & Secondary Boys

Prep to Year 12

Winter (optional extra)

The following extra items may be worn as the weather dictates. The V-neck jumper and Podium Jacket can be worn individually or together.

- Navy V-neck knitted jumper with CCC Logo
- Navy Podium Jacket with CCC Logo



Students can wear personal items under the uniform for extra warmth, but they cannot be visible

Girls Formal Uniform Summer

Primary Girls Prep to Year 6

- College navy bucket hat
- Sky blue blouse with CCC Logo
- Navy crossover tie
- Navy culotte and/or navy dress pants
- Plain white ankle socks



Secondary Girls

Year 7 to Year 12

- College navy bucket hat
- Sky blue blouse with CCC Logo
- · Navy tie with red diagonal stripes To be worn all year
- Navy box pleat skirt and/or navy dress pants
- Plain white ankle socks

Years 11 & 12 only

Navy blazer with red piping*

Note: Navy box pleat skirt or pants are to be worn with the blazer

*Blazers are loaned out via an agreement with the College. There is no additional cost.



Girls Formal Uniform Winter

Primary & Secondary Girls

Prep to Year 12

Winter (optional extra)

The following extra items may be worn as the weather dictates: The V-neck jumper and podium jacket can be worn individually or together.

- Navy V-neck knitted jumper with CCC Logo
- Navy Podium Jacket with CCC Logo
- Navy tights Primary
- Navy stockings Secondary

Sport & House Uniform

Sport Uniform

Prep to Year 12 | Boys & Girls

- College navy bucket hat
- College sky blue polo shirt
- Navy sports short (Creswell or Canterbury with navy branding only)
- Plain white socks

Shorts must be purchased from the College uniform shop

House Uniform Prep to Year 12 | Boys & Girls

- College navy bucket hat
- College House polo (green for Shadrach or red for Meshach)
- Navy sports short (Creswell or Canterbury with navy branding only)
- Plain white socks

Shorts must be purchased from the College uniform shop

Sport & House Uniform Winter

Winter (optional extra)

- Navy podium jacket
- Navy/sky blue zip front track suit jacket with CCC Logo
- Navy track suit pant



Shoes

Shoes form part of our uniform, and the following are the two uniform options: *Please note the definite heel and sole on dress shoes.*



Wear completely black trainers that have all leather uppers, are traditionally laced or Velcro, and able to be polished with black polish.



Wear traditional Clark or Bata like style entirely black leather school shoes for formal uniform, and the approved completely black leather trainers, shown in *Option A*, for Sports/House uniform days.

Maintenance of Trainers and School Shoes

All shoes need to be correctly tied with black laces or Velcro. Black shoe polish to be used on all shoes to maintain condition. Please note, no other shoe is permitted for school use except when competing in formal athletics or team competitive games. On these occasions, specific competition shoes (e.g. footy boots) may be used.

Formal and Sport/House uniform are not to be interchanged (excluding the podium jacket) i.e. the Sports/House winter track jacket cannot be worn over formal uniform and the formal winter jumper cannot be worn over the sport/house uniform.
