

POSITION TITLE: Inclusive Education Teacher

MAIN PURPOSE OF ROLE: Catering for the educational and pastoral needs of students identified as requiring learning support.

DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE TO: Inclusive Education Coordinator

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Planning units of work and lessons for students withdrawn to receive targeted learning support.
- Writing modified assessment tasks for students on Support Plans.
- Monitoring the academic progress and social/emotional development of students on modified programs through observation, assessment and regular consultation with both class teachers and teacher aides.
- Supporting teachers and teacher aides with strategies and resources as they assist students who are on Support Plans.
- Conducting meetings with families and teachers to review Support Plans for students
- Gathering information and data to assist in the completion of Verification documentation.
- Support the Inclusive Education Coordinator in the collection of data
- Writing Semester Reports for students for whom they are responsible.
- Assisting teachers in the writing of Semester Reports for students on Support Plans.
- Organising the storage and access of special needs resources.
- Maintaining regular communication with the Inclusive Education Coordinator.

Essential qualities / qualifications / skills of teachers:

- With God's enabling, ensure your conduct and relationships with colleagues, students and parents are consistent with the standards in God's Word.
- Commit to and support the Ethos, Mission, Vision and Policies and Procedures of Chinchilla Christian College as they relate to the scope of the position.
- Be a person of Christian faith and integrity.
- Teach from a Christian Worldview.
- Enjoy working with children and young people.
- Deal patiently with students of differing abilities.
- Communicate simply and clearly.

- Be knowledgeable or willing to commit to training in current curriculum and teaching practices.
- Be team orientated, and work well cooperatively (including a commitment to non-gossiping communicative practices).
- Commit to ongoing computer literacy development to meet the minimum planning, administrative and teaching requirements.
- It is desirable for to hold a current Senior First Aid and CPR certificate

Teachers demonstrate a commitment to safety by:

- Adhering to CCM and Chinchilla Christian College values and policies in relation to workplace health and safety, striving towards zero harm.
- Promoting within your sphere of influence the importance of health and safety in the workplace.
- Being vigilant and alert to potential and actual safety risks and hazards in the workplace and taking appropriate actions.
- Embracing an active reporting culture of hazards, incidents and near misses.
- Fostering a positive safety culture through being vigilant for the safety of yourself and others and not hesitating to intervene to prevent an unsafe act or condition.
- Wearing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) where required.
- Understanding and following approved safety related policies and procedures.
